



## A Message from the Presidents

We would like to extend a very warm welcome to all riders, judges, officials, sponsors, supporters and spectators at the 2024 Vivant Equi Kiwi Arena Rakes Premier League Show!

We have a full program lined up for all levels of DNZ graded competition as well as Young Dressage Horse, and Para Equestrian. This year, we've introduced a non-graded championship based on feedback from our local groups, aimed at being more inclusive and encouraging. A special welcome to these riders, and we hope you have an inspiring experience, especially if this is your first Premier League dressage event (...or your first in a while). If you have any questions or concerns your friendly stewarding team and organizing committee are here to help.

Additionally, we've added Para Equestrian Novice (National) tests to the program to remove barriers to participation for newcomer para riders. We're pleased to see the Para sport being well supported.

We are excited to team up with Dressage New Zealand High Performance to bring you "An Evening with Melissa Galloway," fresh from the Paris Olympics, in a special fundraiser event on Saturday night. This event kicks off the New Zealand campaign to send a team to Aachen WEG 2026 our pathway to team qualification for the Los Angeles Olympics 2028, and it promises to be inspiring!

The future is bright for the sport with strong participation coming through the Young Rider ranks. This year there are also some great spot prizes to be awarded in recognition of fair play, sportsmanship, and horsemanship - all riders at the show 25 years of age and under are eligible. Nominations can be submitted at the office, and prizes will be awarded throughout the weekend with an overall best of the best on the final day to receive a \$50 voucher from Tackshop.co.nz. Thanks to the Tackshop and the Dressage NZ Youth Council for supporting this initiative, and our Young Rider rep Cat for organizing it.

Those who have attended in previous years will have noticed we have gone \*orange\* with a new look, and a new naming sponsor: A huge thank you to Vivant Equi, who took over the reins (from our previous long standing naming sponsors Oro Equestrian) this year! 



## Awards and Eligibility Criteria

### **Champion and Reserve Champion**

#### Levels 1-9 and Para Equestrian:

Points will be allocated across the classes indicated in each level in order to calculate the Champion & Reserve place getters for Bronze, Silver and Gold Championships. In the event of a tie the combination with the highest placing in the Super 5 test will be the winner or for Para, the highest score in the Para Grand Prix Test B will be the winner. In the event of a further tie, the highest average percentage for the three championship tests will be the winner. t

The OC reserves the right to merge championships within a level where insufficient entries are received.

Points are awarded as follows: 1st place = 20 points to 20th place = 1 point

### **Other Awards**

**McDreamy Trophy: Best Performed BOP Combination** - Donated by Kellie Hamlett. Riders competing in Prelim - GP are eligible and must be a current financial member of one of the 4 BOP dressage groups. In the event of a tie, the horse contesting the highest level will be the winner.

**Best Performed Young Rider** - on a horse or pony, rider must be over 16 and up to 21 years of age as of 1st August 2023.

**Best Performed Junior Rider** - on a horse or pony, rider may be up to and including 16 years as of 1st August 2023.

Note - For the FEI Young Rider Championship classes: Young Riders include riders from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn twelve years (12) until they turn twenty-one (21) years of age. If a rider turns twenty-one (21) on or after 1 August they may continue to compete in Young Rider competitions until 31 July in the following calendar year, (ESNZ dressage rules - Article 402.4 https://www.nzequestrian.org.nz/esnz/rules-regulations/dressage-rules/)

#### Award Criteria

- In recognition of an outstanding positive influence on dressage in the Bay of Plenty.
- Any Dressage BOP member is eligible for nomination, whether they be a rider, judge, administrator, volunteer, etc. Nominees from outside the BOP may be considered at the discretion of the BOP committee.
- NB: The four BOP area dressage groups are Dressage Rotorua, Taupo Dressage Group, Dressage Tauranga, Eastern Bay of Plenty Dressage.
- Nominations to be put forward by a Dressage BOP member and can be put forward throughout the year.
- Nominations close at 12pm on Sunday of the BOP Dressage Championships.
- A sub-committee consisting of a representative from each club and a steward will vote to decide the recipient, in consultation with a representative of the Jenkins Family.
- To be awarded annually at the BOP Dressage Championships.
- The committee reserve the right to modify or amend the nomination criteria if it is deemed necessary to preserve the spirit with which the award is intended.

#### Make a nomination

#### Guidelines for nominations

This award is to acknowledge a person that:

- Steps-up and put themselves out there despite the risk of failure.
- Sets goals and try even though they may have doubts/fears.
- Goes above and beyond to make their achievement(s) meaningful, whether it is for themselves, someone else or a group of people.
- Tries no matter what.

#### **Example nominations**

Nominations can include (but not limited to):

- A judge who judges at Nationals/HOY or overseas for the first time.
- An administrator who leads by example in the face of challenges.
- A rider who sets an ambitious goal (for them) and works away to achieve it.
- A rider who steps up to say FEI level or Grand Prix with the horse that they have trained/bred/loved.
- A rider or judge who is battling serious illness or disability.
- A very generous owner or amazing coach who makes a difference in their own way.

**2023 Recipient:** Angle Taylor was nominated for her outstanding volunteer service as a writer at BOP and other shows for at least a decade.

All other class rosettes may be collected from the office.






